

## WAM Hall of Fame Guidelines

The intent behind the Hall of Fame is to recognise outstanding and ongoing contributions to the West Australian contemporary music sector across all facets of the industry.

Up until 2005, various awards of a similar nature had been made over the years. In 2005, the first official Hall of Fame inductions were made.

The inductees are recognised for their significant contribution to West Australia's music scene for a number of years.

The guidelines for nominations and induction into the **WAM Hall of Fame** are:

- Can be a band, artist, or other industry professional.
- Must have significant achievements, preferably at a national or international level. Local achievements should be exceptional.
- Must identify, or be readily identifiable as a West Australian.
- Can be a posthumous induction
- There can be up to three inductions in any one year

The WAM board make the inductee selection each year.
